Kevin Bilger is Managing Director of AWE plc. Prior to assuming this key leadership position in October 2014, he served as Vice President of Programs and Quality for Lockheed Martin Space Systems Company.

Prior to serving in these roles, Bilger was Vice President and General Manager of Global Communications Systems for Lockheed Martin Space Systems Company, a position he assumed in January 2009. In this role, Bilger led an award-winning team responsible for delivering the nation's premier military communications systems and commercial communications satellites for international customers. He also served in other key executive leadership positions with Space Systems, including Vice President of Programs; Vice President of Subcontract & Product Management; Vice President of the Space Based Infrared System; Vice President of Military Space Programs; and Vice President of Engineering.

Bilger began his career with Lockheed Martin in 1982, as a summer intern. He earned a bachelor's of science in chemical engineering from the University of California, San Diego, and a master's of science in materials science and engineering from Stanford University. He is also a Sloan Fellow graduate from Stanford University, where he earned a second master's of science in management.

Currently, Bilger is a senior advisor for Industry Initiatives for Science & Math Education in Silicon Valley, and served on the board of directors for Ronald McDonald House. He is an American Institute of Aeronautics & Astronautics Associate Fellow and member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers.
